Where? All classes will be taught in Emerald Coast Scuba's on-site classroom and all dive training will be conducted in our state-of-the-art heated saltwater pool with checkout dives taking place at Vortex Springs, Morrison Springs, as well as cleanups in Destin and surrounding areas. Daily schedules with locations and timelines will be sent to all parents the day before each class.

How much? The total cost of the program will be \$1749.50. Payment in full is required upon signup in order to ensure your spot in your chosen session.

Who? Homeschool students ages 12-17 are eligible to participate. All students must be medically cleared and able to comfortably swim 300yrds unassisted wearing a mask, snorkel, and fins as well as complete a 10-minute safety float/tread in water too deep in which to stand.
